Action Items:

School Uniforms

- To get school uniforms, Council must make a motion to approve them. From there the school would do an online vote on the policy.
- There must be 75% in agreement based on the old policy.
- Council would agree to fund the families that cannot afford uniforms.
- There are many pros and cons arguments and parents would be encouraged to attend a meeting to answer any questions they might have.
- There might be a new policy coming out in the fall that would only require 60% in agreement.
- Will table this discussion in September

Maintenance/Repair of School Yard

- There was a concern regarding the transition between the pavement, gravel, and grass. Mr. Birkenbergs put in a request to fix it. They need to level the gravel screen up to pavement edge and the pavement needs re done.
- There are also complaints regarding a lot of garbage throughout the yard. The custodian does do yard clean up but is tricky as there is also public traffic that are allowed to walk throughout the yard.

Tuck Shop/Snack Shop

- Council would like to have a Tuck Shop/Snack Shop at the school to help raise funds. The idea was to sell stuff like popcorn, milk, and cookies at \$2 per item.
- Georges Vanier is currently in the Healthy Schools program which does not allow for snack sales.
- We also get funding for the YMCA and PC program. This year we spent \$29000 on healthy snacks through this program. If we do not get into the PC program, then YMCA does not have this restriction. We will find out in September
