Fundraising:

Big box of Cards

-Our profit from Big Box of Cards was \$1582. There was also \$570 in donations. Our profit was \$2152 but we spent approximately \$225 on the prizes and pizza party.

Graduation:

- -Council donates \$500 every year to graduation. Council would like to know what that money goes towards. In the past, the money has been used to purchase a class composite for each graduating student.
- -We will discuss at the next meeting about donating the money this year.

Outdoor Classroom:

- -We have been earmarking our fundraising money to purchase and outdoor classroom for the students.
- -Mara got a quote from a tendered company for 3 metal benches, without a back so students could sit on either side of the bench. Each bench would cost \$400.00 uninstalled. We would need to contact another tendered company to have all the prep work done.

-Mr. Birkenbergs stated that we will not be able to pour a concrete slab in the field as it is a safety hazard and that it is up to the board to decide how it gets installed.

Christmas Cookie Giveaway

-We need to decide by next meeting if we will be giving out Christmas cookies to the students, so it gives us enough time to order them.

Pancake Day:

-There are no restrictions anymore regarding doing events at the school however, there are restrictions on food handling. If food is to be prepared at the school, it would require and inspection. There is not any food preparation allowed at the school and that is why the school catered the BBQ.

Pizza Days:

-Pizza day will be held on Wednesdays. The pizza will be ordered from Gino's.

Lunch Lady:

-Lunch lady is a program that provides a prepackaged lunch to students who order it. This would give students other options of ordering food other than pizza. A rep would come and call the kids down who have ordered lunch.
-Sandra will look further into this.

Milk Program:

-The milk program is supposed to run daily. Mr. Birkenbergs will speak to some teachers and look into the program to get it set up.

Chips and Popcorn:

-We will not longer be able to sell anything from the Snack Centre like chips and popcorn as everything should be cash online.

50th Anniversary:

-Due to covid, we were unable to have any celebration for the 50th Anniversary of Georges Vanier School. Mr. Birkenbergs is thinking of doing something during advent time with Father Imperial. We could have a mass at the church and an event at the hall. We will know more after the board says what is going on.

Christmas Event:

- -Mr. Birkenbergs thought of doing a drop in Christmas event at the school. The idea would be students can get individual craft kids and they can go to their classrooms with their parents to do them.
- -We also thought that during the event, we could set up to have the Santa pictures with the children at the hall. Lifetouch no longer offers it, but we will see what we can do.

Halloween for Dance:

-Mr. Birkenbergs is looking into hiring a DJ for a Halloween dance.

The quote for that was \$775. Instead of doing a fundraiser, his idea was to consider doing a donation drive where parents would donate for example \$20 per family. If we do that twice a year, times 175 families we would make approx. the same as our fundraisers but without the work of the school, council and families selling stuff.

-The Halloween dance would be an example of what we can offer the kids to do the donation drive.
