## **Christmas Cookie Giveaway**

-Snowman Cookie giveaway happened the week before Christmas break. The kids loved the cookies. Thank you to all who volunteered their time to hand out cookies!

#### **Hot Chocolate**

-Christmas Open House was a wonderful event, thank you to the Staff and Mr. Birkenbergs for organizing the evening. Council provided hot chocolate for the event. Williams Café (on Queen Street) catered the hot chocolate for us, they delivered it to the school with all the cups. We ordered enough for 250 people at a cost of \$474.60. Cookies were donated by the Salvino Family and Candy Canes were donated by the Schiavello Family. Thank you to the volunteers who handed out the hot chocolate that evening.

### **Lunch Lady Program**

-Shrove Tuesday Pancakes will be catered by Lunch Lady. This evening we voted on the 2 pancake option at \$2.50 per student. Pancakes will come in bulk packaging. Each teacher would receive enough for their class along with syrup, plates, napkins and utensils. Sandra will get the current class lists to give to Pam from Lunch Lady. Mr. Birkenbergs will send out opt out letter to all students. It will also note that the pancakes are not a substitute for lunch and parents must still provide a lunch for their children.

#### **Donation Drive**

-Thank you to all who participated. We raised \$1705.00 (as per the report Sandra received before Christmas). That is an incredible amount of money for not selling a tangible item. It rivals profits we have made with other fundraising efforts. As we had mentioned we were going to hand out prizes to the top donors. It was voted on that anyone who donated over \$60 would receive a \$25 gift card to Indigo and those who donated \$50 would receive a \$10 Dairy Queen Card. Everyone who participated will receive a participation gift (which we have in the hub room).
